GEORGE HERRICK And Other Outstandig Sports Columnists and Writers Every Day in Your Track-and-field interest has been growing in San Diego and Imperial Counties, spurred by the highly-successful Pre-Olympic Invitational here last summer and the National AAU championships, which will be held in Balboa Stadium June 26-27 with an international field competing.

To meet this interest, the San Diego Evening Tribune presents this first edition of its San Diego-Imperial Counties Track and Field Guide.

San Diego always has produced its share of sectional and state prep champions. San Diego High, in the 1920s, turned out Olympic-class pole vaulters almost every year. Foremost is Bill Miller, who is on the cover of this Guide. Miller first gained prominence at San Diego High, vaulting 13 feet, 3 inches in 1929, a mark which still stands as the school record. He later went to Stanford University and became the Olympic champion in 1932 at 14-1%.

In the 1930s there was a great quartermiler who came out of El Centro named Myrel Gillette. He won the 1933 state championship, and his mark of :48.3 still is the best recorded by a San Diego-Imperial County athlete.

Later came Willie Steele, Hal Norris, Bob Staten, Roscoe Cook and, in the last few seasons, Vernus Ragsdale, Eddy Hanks and Bob Hose, all of whom gained national recognition for their performances.

This Guide represents the first compilation of these and other records of past achievements of San Diego and Imperial County track-and-field performers. While every effort has been made to make it the most complete possible, some brilliant performances may have been missed.

Some records are not included because their validity has been questioned. Others were lost with the passage of time and no longer are available.

Another factor of missing records may be that they were achieved in dual meets where there was no recording of wind conditions and where accurate measurement of distances is questionable.

The National AAU championships aren't the only major event scheduled on the San Diego track calendar. In 1966, the California prep championships, a two-day meet, will be held here for the first time.

The CIF, Southern Section meet was held here for the first and only time in 1946. Balboa Stadium will be the site of the 1966 event.


